

DHA PESHAWAR BALLOT 2026
Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)
Ballot Date: 10 September 2026

1. When will the DHA Peshawar Ballot 2026 be held?

The DHA Peshawar Ballot 2026 is scheduled to be held on **10 September 2026**.

2. Which Affidavit Files will be eligible for inclusion in the Ballot?

All eligible **Affidavit Files issued on or before 5 September 2026** will be considered for inclusion in the Ballot, subject to fulfillment of the applicable terms and conditions.

3. Are Intimation Letters also eligible for the Ballot?

Yes. Eligible **Intimation Letters issued on or before 5 September 2026** will also be considered for inclusion in the Ballot, subject to fulfillment of the prescribed requirements.

4. What is the last date for issuance of an Affidavit File or Intimation Letter for Ballot eligibility?

The relevant **Affidavit File or Intimation Letter must be issued on or before 5 September 2026** to qualify for consideration in the Ballot.

5. What is the deadline for clearing outstanding dues?

Any amount falling due **up to 10 September 2026** must be fully cleared **by 5 September 2026**.

6. If an installment is due on 10 September 2026, does it need to be paid before the Ballot?

Yes. Any amount payable up to and including **10 September 2026** must be deposited no later than **5 September 2026** for the file to meet the applicable Ballot requirements.

7. Can a file with outstanding dues participate in the Ballot?

A file will be considered for the Ballot only after fulfillment of the applicable requirements, including clearance of all amounts due up to **10 September 2026** by the prescribed deadline of **5 September 2026**.

8. Is partial payment sufficient for Ballot eligibility?

No. Where an amount is due up to 10 September 2026, the relevant outstanding amount must be cleared in accordance with the prescribed requirements. Partial payment should not be considered equivalent to full clearance of dues.

9. Does inclusion in the Ballot guarantee allotment of a plot?

No. **Eligibility for and inclusion in the Ballot does not by itself guarantee successful allotment or allocation of a plot number.** The final outcome will be determined through the Ballot process.

10. Are Affidavit Files and Intimation Letters subject to the same cutoff date?

Yes. Under the current instructions, both **Affidavit Files and Intimation Letters issued up to 5 September 2026** are covered by the announced cutoff, subject to fulfillment of the applicable conditions.

11. Will files issued after 5 September 2026 be included in this Ballot?

Under the currently announced instructions, the Ballot covers eligible Affidavit Files and Intimation Letters issued **up to 5 September 2026**. Files or letters issued after this date should not be assumed to be eligible for the 10 September 2026 Ballot unless otherwise officially notified by DHA Peshawar.

12. What happens if payment is made on 5 September but is reflected in the system later?

Customers are advised to make payments well before the deadline and retain the official payment receipt or other acceptable proof of payment. Any matter relating to payment posting or system reflection should be taken up with the concerned DHA Peshawar office before the Ballot.

13. Will there be any extension beyond 5 September 2026?

No extension should be presumed. Customers and dealers should complete all required formalities within the announced deadline unless DHA Peshawar issues a separate official notification.

14. Will DHA Peshawar offices remain open to facilitate customers before the Ballot?

Yes. For the convenience of customers and dealers, the concerned DHA Peshawar offices will remain open up to **5 September 2026** according to the notified extended working hours.

15. What are the extended office timings?

The notified timings are:

- **Monday to Friday:** 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM
- **Saturday:** 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM

16. Where can customers deposit their payments?

In addition to the relevant DHA Peshawar offices, customers may use the notified **Askari Commercial Bank Collection Facility, Plaza No. FC, Nasir Bagh Road, Peshawar**, during the applicable working hours.

17. What should customers do before 5 September 2026?

Customers are advised to:

- Confirm that their Affidavit File or Intimation Letter has been properly issued.
- Verify their outstanding dues.
- Clear all amounts payable up to 10 September 2026.
- Retain proof of payment.
- Resolve any discrepancy in file or payment status before the deadline.

18. How can a customer confirm whether a file has fulfilled the Ballot requirements?

Customers should verify their file status, issuance status and payment position through the concerned DHA Peshawar office or any other officially notified verification channel.

19. Should customers rely on information circulated by dealers or social media pages?

Customers are strongly advised to rely only on **official DHA Peshawar notifications and authorized communication channels** for information regarding Ballot eligibility, deadlines, payments and results.

20. What is the most important deadline to remember?

The key date for customers is:

5 September 2026 — Deadline for issuance of eligible Affidavit Files / Intimation Letters and clearance of all applicable dues payable up to 10 September 2026.

The Ballot itself will be held on:

10 September 2026.

Important Advisory

Customers and dealers are encouraged to complete all required formalities well before the deadline to avoid last-minute payment, verification or processing issues. DHA Peshawar should be contacted directly in case of any discrepancy concerning file issuance, outstanding dues or Ballot eligibility.
